1 Essential MacOS X Lion Keyboard Shortcuts

1.1. Introduction

Here are the most useful shortcuts that I commonly use in MacOS X Lion. It is primarily focused on shortcuts which allows you to navigate between applications, windows and screens.

Mission Control provides special views to help you navigate. Mission Control views are also suitable for keyboard navigation. Try \leftarrow , \rightarrow , \uparrow , \downarrow , SPACE and \leftarrow when activated.

Note that most shortcuts may be customized in Preferences -> Keyboard -> Keyboard Shortcuts.
